TERMS OF REFERENCE

DIVERSITY COMMITTEE

CONSTITUTION

The Diversity committee will contain at least the following members:

1. Convener of the Committee
2. Immediate Past Convener of the Committee (if there is one and they are willing)
3. Ordinary member(s)
4. New Zealand member
5. Singapore member

The committee may have further members, as many as deemed necessary for its necessary functioning, although consideration should be given to a maximum size of 7 or 8 members, as more may prove unwieldy. One member of the committee will act as Secretary.

FUNCTION

- To advise Executive, and make recommendations where appropriate, on how best to promote diversity in the profession of Philosophy in Australasia.
- To devise and carry out projects that support diversity in the profession of Philosophy in Australasia.
- To monitor the environment for issues concerning diversity in the profession of Philosophy in Australasia.
- To work with the Executive in awarding prizes.

UNDERSTANDING OF DIVERSITY

The AAP understands diversity along a number of dimensions including gender, ethnicity and sexuality, as well as including approaches and traditions in philosophy.
