

TERMS OF REFERENCE

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT COMMITTEE

CONSTITUTION

The Undergraduate Student Committee will consist of the following members, including at least one person from all of the regions:

- 1. Convener of the Committee
- 2. Immediate Past Convener of the Committee (if there is one)
- 3. Ordinary undergraduate member(s)
- 4. Advisor/mentor to the committee (an academic ideally at the University from which the convenor comes)
- 5. New Zealand member
- 6. Singapore member

The committee may have further members, as many as deemed necessary for its necessary functioning, although consideration should be given to a maximum size of 7 or 8 members, as more may prove unwieldy. One member of the committee will act as Secretary.

FUNCTION

- To advise the Executive on matters of importance to undergraduate philosophy students
- To facilitate and coordinate networks between university philosophy clubs and the AAP
- To develop and undertake projects to support philosophy undergraduates in Australasia.
- To liaise on a needs be basis with the convenor of the Postgraduate Student Committee on matters of mutual relevance.

SCHEDULE A

To facilitate and coordinate the bidding for undergraduate conferences in philosophy and to make recommendations to the Executive about the allocation of undergraduate conference funds in any given year.

To develop shared resources.
